#### FES Malaysia's beginnings:

FES Malaysia was birthed in 1962 in University Malaya. Since then the number of tertiary institutions and students have increased manifold.

#### Malaysia's Student world today:

Cover 500 tertiary institutions
 (colleges and universities both public and private)
 500 to 600 thousand tertiary students
 Estimated 90% of these students are not Christians

#### HOWEVER, FES Malaysia currently has:
