Running simultaneously with these is the Combined Students Mission Trip to Pantu led by Thomas Rabang (8/5 - 18/5) & the PPK UiTM Return to Betong

Mission (accompanied by Peter Paris). Please pray for the safety of both staff & students as they travel about.

Coming up in June (12 - 25) is a new program called **SWEEP** (Social Work Exposure and Embracement Program). It will provide students with exposure, experience and hands-on approach to social work. Students will be trained via talks & simulations, and sent to a children's home for practical experience. Please pray for Shelter Home, David & Lian Chui who are running this program.

We desire to bless the students especially international and outstation students, who may not be able to bring all that they need, from their homes. As such, they can purchase useful items at a nominal price at a **bazaar** to be held in **Oasis** on 24/6. Do pray for us as we organise this event and coordinate the collection of useful items for the bazaar.

Last but not least, join us in prayer for the release of finances to enable the work to go on. The **deficit** as at 1st April stands at RM66,950. Thank you for praying along with us.
